Association Volunteer Recognition Award Nomination Criteria

Association Volunteer of the Year

Each year, Community Living Toronto selects one individual as the Association's Volunteer of the Year. This individual must have made an outstanding contribution(s) that has affected the lives of the individuals we support and/or their families. This may be through direct service, contribution on Association Committees or other activities/events.

Volunteer Recognition Award

In addition to the Association Volunteer of the Year, Community Living Toronto presents awards to other volunteer leaders who support the work of the Association and the people supported by it, including:

- a volunteer leader from each of Community Living Toronto's four regions
- a volunteer from Public Relations
- a volunteer leader from Fundraising
- a self-advocate leader

In total, there are eight awards presented.

Frequency of Awards

All Volunteer Recognition Awards are presented annually at the Association's Volunteer Recognition Dinner in April.

Criteria

Award nominations will be based on, but not limited to:

- Length of time involved with Community Living Toronto
- Nature of support/partnership
- Impact of support/partnership on Community Living Toronto's:
 - Presence in the community
 - Impact on the people supported by the Association
 - Impact, if any, on the greater Community Living movement
 - Relationships with corporate and community partners

Nomination Process

Each January, the regions, departments and Committees will generate a list of potential nominees. Nominations are submitted and selected by Regional Councils, or in the case of Public Relations and Fundraising nominations, to the Resource Development Committee. The selected nominee is then submitted to the Board of Directors for approval in March.

The 'Association Volunteer of the Year' nominations are submitted to the Nominating Committee of the Board of Directors. All current members are eligible to submit a nomination. A recommendation is submitted by the Nominating Committee to the Board at the March Board meeting.
