Under the direction of program supervisor and with the input of the individual and their supports, responsibilities include:

- Identifying and evaluating community resources, then connecting individuals based on their person directed plan.
- Revising plans in consultation with the individual/families.
- Preparing reports and correspondence and following financial protocols.
- Assessing person's skills providing training in identified areas.
- Facilitating empowerment of the individual/families to make choices in where they will live, learn, work and play.
- Supporting volunteers and other people that will assist the person in reaching their outcomes.

HOURS OF WORK: Up to 24 hours per week – **Work schedule may include working days, afternoons, overnights and weekends.**
