Eligibility

This program is for children between the ages of 11-17 with a primary diagnosis of an Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Dates

This program runs for 4 nights/5 days in August every year. There are six spaces available. Autism Camp at Shadow Lake Centre has a 1:2 staff/camper ratio. Children attending have the opportunity to participate in all the activities that Shadow Lake Centre has to offer. All meals are included.

Summer Day Respite
