PPE Useage Guidelines



A procedural mask should be worn by all staff when entering the location for the duration of their shift.

Daily Activities

- •Food prep and serving (Use kitchen gloves if available)
- •General household cleaning including disinfecting
- Performing hygiene tasks from 1 m away (providing instructions)
 - •Taking out garbage/recycling
 - Washing and folding unsoiled laundry
 - Medication Administration using a med cup
 - Cleaning
 - •ADL's

Situations where suspected or probable cases of COVID-19 do not exist

PPE





MASK is required at all times

WASH YOUR HANDS AND DON'T TOUCH YOUR FACE!

Supporting individuals <u>without any signs</u> of infection with the following:

- Changing briefs
- •Administering any sublingual and topical medication
- Providing direct contact support during hygiene
 - Soiled clothing/bedding routines



Mask & Gloves are required

Suspected, Probable or Confirmed Case of COVID-19

Staff providing direct care (within 1 meter) to an individual with a <u>suspected, probable</u> or <u>confirmed</u> case of COVID-19:

- Daily Living Skills
 - Hygiene
- Medication Administration

All other staff should continue to wash their hands frequently, regularly clean high touch surfaces and avoid touching their mask, face, and eyes.



All of the indicated PPE must be worn when providing direct support (within 1 metre).

Note: All staff working in CLTO locations will be provided a surgical/procedural mask to be worn for the duration of their shift.

Replacement masks are available, as needed. Follow the donning and doffing of PPE instructions on the proper techniques for putting on and removing PPE including the mask. Continue to follow contact/droplet precautions for the use of PPE and isolation of individuals who are suspected/probable/confirmed COVID-19

Full PPE (gloves, masks, glasses or goggles, gown) - glasses and goggles are reusable and should be sanitized

Staff should not eat in groups, and should maintain social distancing of at least 2 metres (6 feet) at all times, where possible. When removing the mask to eat or drink, follow the doffing (removing) PPE instructions and place it inside up on a clean surface, such as a clean paper towel, to avoid contamination. Staff should always remember to perform hand hygiene. The Mask can be reused provided it is not soiled. Discard at the end of shift.
