# Campaign Commitments from the Political Parties



May 30, 2022

#### **Progressive Conservative (PC) Party**

- Permanent wage enhancement for DS sector
- 5% ODSP rate increase
- Expanding the Home and Vehicle Modification Program



### New Democratic Party (NDP)



- Permanent wage enhancement for DS sector
- 60000 new supportive housing units
- 10% of National Housing Strategy funds to build and maintain DS housing
- 20% ODSP rate increase in first year, double rate in second; index to inflation
- Ending the practice of forcing people to reapply for services after turning 18
- Restart the Basic Income Pilot



## **Ontario Liberal Party (OLP)**

- Permanent wage enhancement for DS sector
- At least 2500 new units for people with developmental disabilities
- 10% of National Housing Strategy funds to build and maintain DS housing
- 38000 new supportive housing units plus funding
- 20% ODSP rate increase over two years; index flat rate to inflation
- Increase minimum Passport allocation to \$6000
- Better health care access
- Restart the Basic Income Pilot



## **Green Party of Ontario (GPO)**



- Permanent wage enhancement for DS sector
- 60000 new supportive housing units
- Double ODSP rates; tie further increases to inflation
- Support programs and services that take an intersectional approach to meet the mental health needs of all people, including those with disabilities
- Evaluate and improve the Assistive Devices Program
- Phase-in a Basic Income
