Prior to the first day of camp, all staff participate in a week-long training program, and on-line orientation. Everyone is required to obtain a police check prior to starting work.

Being COVID 19 vaccinated is a condition of employment with Community Loving Toronto. CLTO will comply with the Ontario Human Rights Code (OHRC) and provide accommodation up to the point of undue hardship to the organization to any Prospective Staff, Staff and Essential Visitor who is unable to be vaccinated for substantiated medical or religious reasons.
