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THE ME & LAU FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

The purpose of the ME & Lau Family Foundation ("ME" hereafter) Scholarship is to encourage and promote the attainment of higher education goals for individuals with a proven financial need. Consideration will be given to students who have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement, who have made a positive contribution to people with intellectual disabilities through involvement in extracurricular activities, and who have made significant contributions of time and energy to community services programs.

DESCRIPTION

The Scholarship will be \$1,200 (in Canadian Dollars) to a student pursuing post-secondary education who is selected by ME & Lau Family Foundation's Awards/Scholarships Committee. The funder reserves the right to interview each candidate prior to making a final decision. The purpose of the Scholarship is for post-secondary education expenses such as tuition, books, supplies, and other related expenses. The Scholarship is awarded only in the student's first year at a post-secondary institution and as such applications are limited to one per candidate.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

Residency

- Be a student currently in their final year of high school and will be attending a postsecondary institution in the fall to pursue a minimum of 2 years of full-time study leading to a degree or diploma, in a public college or university within Canada.
- Successfully obtain and provide a copy of their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

Income

• Provide supporting documentation of family income threshold of \$135,000 or below. In the case where no parental support is provided to the student a copy of the Family Breakdown application submitted to OSAP.

Extra-curricular Involvements

• Have made a positive contribution to people with an intellectual disability.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the candidate's academic abilities, the Awards/Scholarships Committee will evaluate the candidate's positive contribution to people with an intellectual disability in the community. Contributions to the community may be demonstrated by involvement in local clubs, activities, and organizations such as Community Living Toronto, Community Living Ontario, DD Community Connector, ME & Lau Family Foundation, etc.

FUNDING AND PAYMENTS

All payments will be made directly to the Scholarship recipient by the ME & Lau Family Foundation. The recipient must provide satisfactory proof of enrollment and an official timetable. Funds will be released after the withdrawal date of the recipient's postsecondary institution.

These references cannot be family or friends and it is preferable that at least one reference is a current or previous teacher.
