



## Counsellors

We are currently seeking counsellors for our Summer 2024 camps. Counsellors work in teams in shifts ensuring the guests are cared for and enjoying their vacation. Counsellors are responsible for:

- Hygiene care (showering, toileting, shaving etc.)
- Following dietary restrictions and ensuring all healthcare needs are met
- Documenting incidents before shift end
- Filling out guest reports
- Creating and implementing recreational activities and adapting them to guests needs
- Being involved in supporting their participants and encouraging their involvement in the program that program team implements
- Using positive behavior management strategies when needed
- Communicate with co-counsellors and all staff about your guests needs
- Follow all Community Living Toronto policies and Shadow Lake Centre Policies
- Attend all staff trainings and meetings

Requirements: Studying in a related field and some related experience (PSW, DSW, Social Work, etc.)

Prior to the first day of camp, all staff participate in a week-long training program, and on-line orientation. Everyone is required to obtain a police check prior to starting work.

Candidates must pass a medical and be free of contagious disease in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements and maintain appropriate immunizations.
