We are seeking Overnight Awake staff for Summer 2024 camps.

As an overnight awake staff, you work in a team to ensure safety and rest during the night. Overnight awake staff are responsible for:

- Hygiene care,
- Ensuring healthcare needs,
- Documenting incidents before shift end
- Filling out overnight logs,
- Using positive behavior management strategies during the night,
- Communicating to supervisors and counsellors about night events.
- Following all Community Living Toronto policies and Shadow Lake Centre Policies
- Attending all staff trainings and meetings.

Experience in working with people with disabilities is beneficial but not required. We provide skill-building and training opportunities and are always looking for enthusiastic, caring, and dedicated staff.

Prior to the first day of camp, all staff participate in a week-long training program, and on-line orientation. Everyone is required to obtain a police check prior to starting work.

Candidates must pass a medical and be free of contagious disease in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements and maintain appropriate immunizations.
