BROADER PUBLIC SECTOR ACCOUNTABILITY

This includes making its rules and practices regarding expenses and perquisites available to the public on its corporate website.

Lobbying

1. During the period of April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025, this organization did not utilize the funds provided by the Government of Ontario to engage a lobbyist for its services.

Expense Rules

1. Members of the Association's volunteer Board of Directors may be remunerated only for reasonable expenses they incur in the performance of their duties.
2. Association employees will be paid/reimbursed for expenses that: are related to business, modest and appropriate, balance economy and efficiency of operations with a healthy and safe workplace, are supported by acceptable documentation, and are properly authorized in accordance with internal policies.
3. Hospitality (i.e. food, beverages, accommodation, transportation, and volunteer/member/staff recognition) is extended as economically as possible. Unless otherwise designated, hospitality expenses are not charged to public or donated funds.
4. All business expenses are subject to internal and external audit.

Perquisites (a benefit enjoyed as a result of one's job or position)

1. CL Toronto does not provide perquisites to any of its volunteers or employees.
2. During the period of April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025, this organization managed its perquisites by following policies which comply with the requirements of the Broader Public Sector Perquisites Directive.
